

The Glenridge on Palmer Ranch Highlands and Isle of Skye Visitation Policy

The health and safety of our members and staff remains our #1 priority.

Visitation is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

All visitors are required to follow the facility's infection control policies and procedures, including cough etiquette, proper hand hygiene, and appropriate use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Education will be provided on an as-needed basis for all visitors. In the event PPE is recommended for visitors, the facility will provide the appropriate PPE.

We ask that all visitors sign in and out at the Reception Desk.

While up-to-date vaccinations are encouraged, visitors are not required to submit proof of any vaccinations or immunizations.

Unless the member or member's legal representative objects, in-person visitation and consensual physical contact is permitted at all times and in all circumstances, with no limitation on the number of visitors or the length of visits.

**Visitors are not screened upon entry; however, we respectfully ask that you
postpone your visit if you:**

have had a fever in the last twenty-four (24) hours

or

have any other symptoms of illness.

And that you return for your visit after:

more than 24 hours have passed since having a fever

and

all other symptoms of illness have resolved.
